

## MEDICAL PROTOCOL

### **The professional content of the Medical Protocol**

*During the medical protocol process, the health care provider fills out a health data sheet, performs screenings and administers vaccinations. When filling out the health data form, the scholarship holder reports about his/her regular medication use and, if applicable, about treatments requiring medical care. The scholarship holder is required to update these data during the scholarship period.*

*The scholarship holder is obligated to inform the health care provider about any change occurred in the above facts/data without delay.*

#### **I. Mandatory elements of health screening tests:**

*a.) TB screening (chest x-ray or QuantiFERON test)*

*b) HIV screening test*

*c. Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C screening*

#### **All scholarship holders must have the following vaccinations:**

*1. Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP); polio vaccination series*

*2. MMR vaccination (2 doses)*

*3. Hepatitis B vaccination*

*a) If the vaccinations described in point 1 are missing, a vaccination plan must be prepared upon enrolment and vaccines must be administered at appropriate intervals. If more than 10 years have passed since the last vaccination, a DTaP booster vaccination is required.*

*b) If the vaccinations described in points 2 and 3 are missing, they must be administered additionally.*

*c) Vaccination must be administered to those arriving from typhoid endemic areas without vaccination.*

#### **II. Optional elements of health screening tests:**

*a) Based on medical history or screening test results, if necessary, specialist examination.*

*b) Possibility of 2 COVID screenings/person during the academic year.*

*Persons specified in Section 80 (2b) of Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education may undertake to comply with the requirements of the medical protocol by making a voluntary declaration.*
